





## Atrial Fibrillation is a Progressive Disease

Long-standing Persistent Afib is the largest Afib patient population<sup>1</sup>









Pulmonary veins (red) are common sites for initiating Afib

Non-pulmonary vein triggers (red arrows) can also initiate and sustain Afib, in patients with advanced forms of Afib

## If Afib is not properly treated, the disease can worsen.
